Where criticism is made, it should be listened to.

This is especially true for criticism from people who are discriminated against.

We share the perspective that on a structural level we are all violating other people's boundaries in different ways. We pursue the goal of causing less harm.

With an open attitude for criticism we want to meet and learn from each other.
